Animal Registration Form: Accommodation Addendum Service Animal Registration Request

- A. Service Animals (Dogs): Per Titles II and III of the Americans with Disabilities Act, College Houses allows a person with a disability to be accompanied by a service animal which is, by definition, limited to dogs. Service animals (or service dogs) are defined as dogs that are individually trained to do work or perform tasks for people with disabilities. Examples of such work or tasks include guiding people who are blind, alerting people who are deaf, pulling a wheelchair, and alerting/protecting a person who is having a seizure. The provision of emotional support, well-being, comfort, or companionship do not constitute work or tasks for the purposes of defining a service dog. The work or task a dog has been trained to provide must be directly related to the person's disability.
- B. Students with service dogs are permitted to bring their service dog in all areas of a place of public accommodation. This includes house common rooms and the dining room. The only area a service dog is prohibited is a food preparation area, such as inside the kitchen.
- C. Approved Service Animals are not considered pets, and therefore do not require a pet fee or deposit.
- D. Service dogs must still be registered with the College Houses office via submitting an Animal Registration Form.
- E. College Houses reserves the right to bill the owner of the animal for the cost of any pest management (for example, flea removal) incurred during their stay. The resident is also responsible for any damage to carpet, furniture, bedding, walls, odor control, etc. above and beyond that which is necessary to put the room back into an acceptable condition. Since the resident owner of a service animal would not have a pet deposit on file, College Houses would directly bill the resident.
- F. Approval: On the Animal Registration Form, you will have the opportunity to note if the animal is **required because of a disability** and **what work or task the animal has been trained to perform.** This information would only be used to confirm your accommodation request; the information provided would not be maintained in your College Houses file.
